**FRIDAY BLITZ SCRAMBLE KICKOFF March 9<sup>th</sup>- Regular Friday Scrambles March 15<sup>th</sup>** Please mark **your calendar** to join us for the Friday Blitz Scrambles. The kickoff tournament for this will be on Saturday, March 9<sup>th</sup> at 1:00. We will play 18 holes and entry is \$25.00 each. Teams will be determined by luck of the draw for this tournament and the regular Friday Blitz Scrambles. Eddie Gilmer is the 2024 tournament committee chairman. He will organize the regular Friday Blitz Scrambles which will be **every Friday beginning March 15<sup>th</sup>** and will run through Friday, August 9<sup>th</sup> with the finale on August 10<sup>th</sup>. Tee time every Friday (weather permitting) is at 5:30. Please note that early in the season we must tee off promptly at 5:30 to finish before dark. **DO YOUR PART:** Take pride in keeping our course neat and clean. Take time to pick up a piece of paper, a can, or bottle and put it in a trash can. Pick up broken Tees on the T-Boxes. Try to keep your carts on the cart path around the greens and T-Boxes. Set an example for others. You'll be surprised how catching it is.

**GOLF CART MAINTENANCE** – This is a perfect time for maintenance on your golf cart. Suggestions: Check the water level in your batteries. (Add distilled water to your batteries). Check the air pressure in your tires (Tires should be inflated to 18 psi per tire). Inspect and clean the battery cables/terminals. (Clean with an aerosol battery terminal cleaner or wire brush and rinse off with water, let dry, then apply non aerosol battery terminal sealer). A little preventative maintenance may save you from missing an opportunity to play golf because your cart won't run. (The maintenance shed has an air compressor and air gauge and you are welcome to use them).

**SAND BOTTLES** – We have some extra sand bottles for your golf carts. They are located at the payment drop box (Honor Box) and at #1 T-Box. Please help yourself and encourage other golfers to use them.
